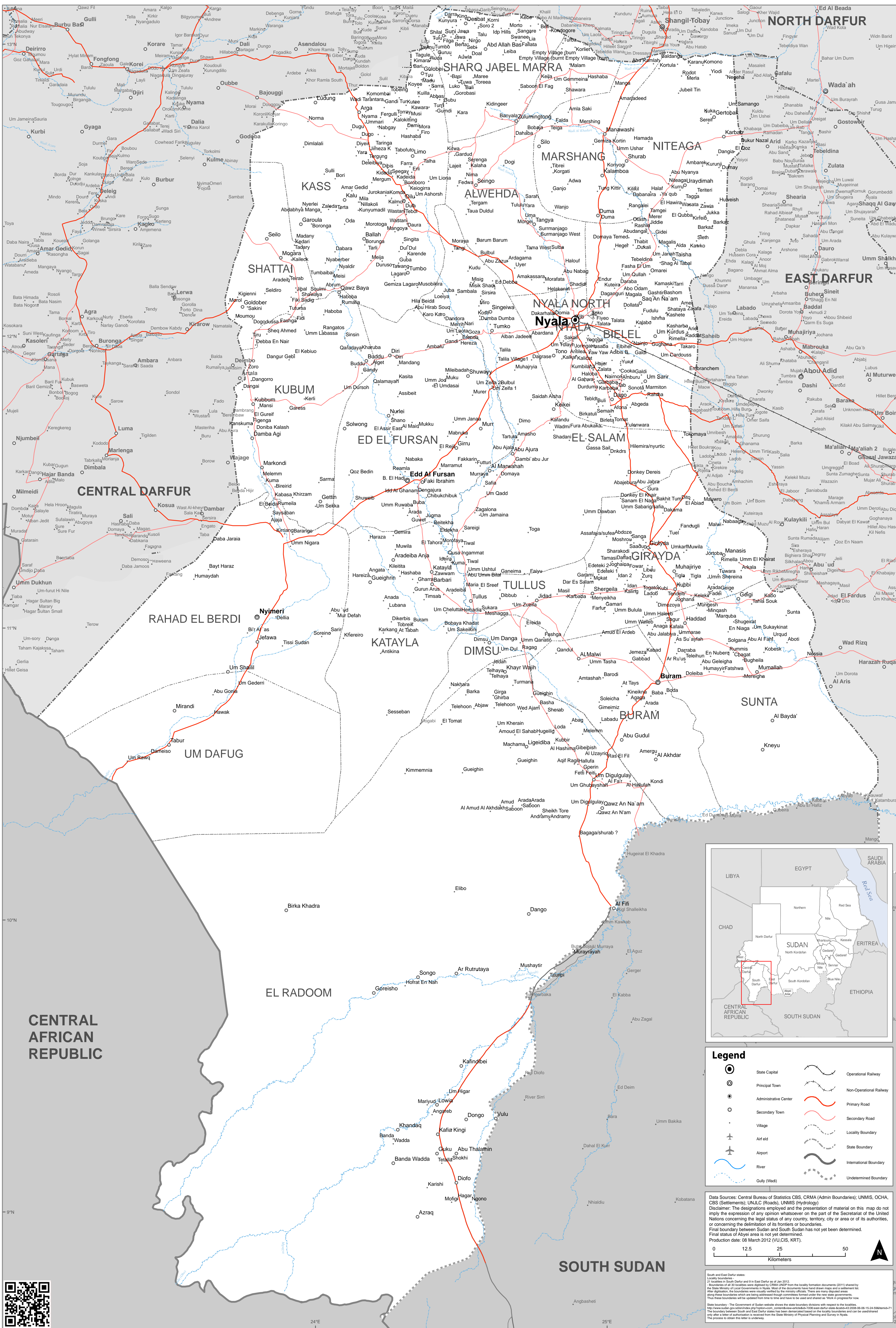


SUDAN: South Darfur State - Administrative Map

South and East Darfur states: Locality boundaries: © Locality boundaries in South Darfur and in East Darfur as of July 2012. Locality boundaries in South Darfur were digitized by OCHA/UNMIS from the locality boundary documents (2011) shared by the State Ministry of Local Governments in Nile. Most of the documents have hand-drawn maps and a settlement list. After digitization, the boundaries were mostly verified by the country offices. There are some disputed areas. Along these boundaries which are being addressed through committees formed under the new state governments. These boundaries will be updated from time to time and have to be used and checked as work in progress for now.
State boundary: The Government of Sudan website shows the state boundary delimitation with respect to the locality.
The boundary between South and East Darfur states has been determined based on the locality boundaries and can be considered only after a letter of authorization is received from the State Ministry of Physical Planning and Survey in Nile. The process to obtain this letter is underway.
