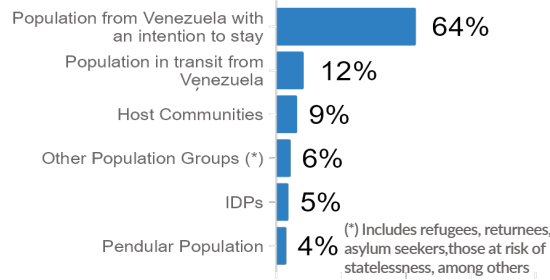

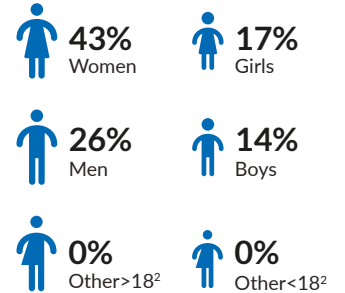

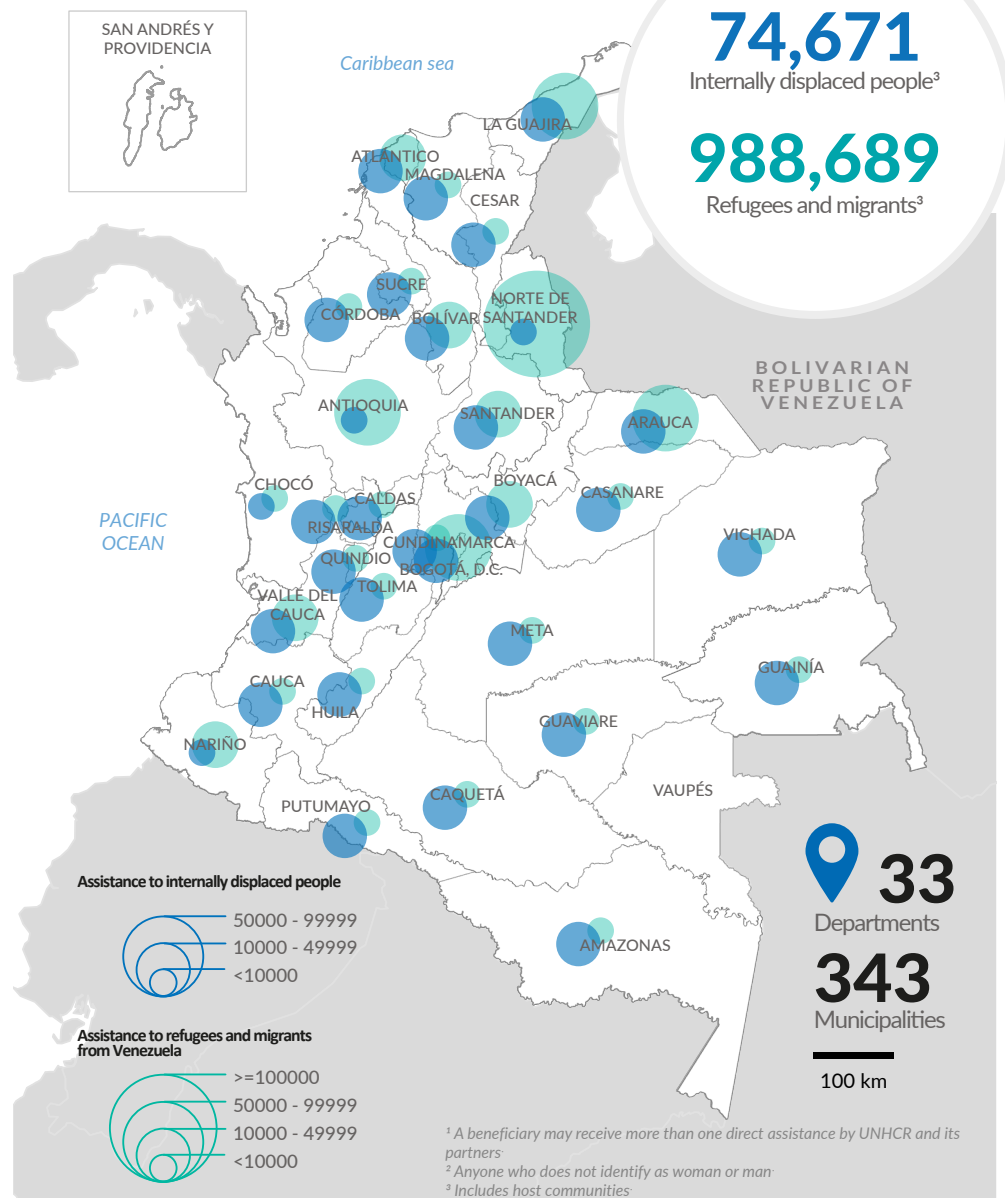

### Geographic location of beneficiaries

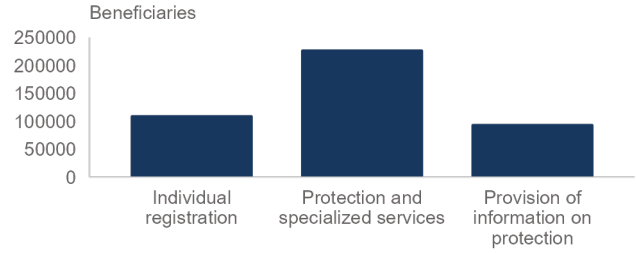

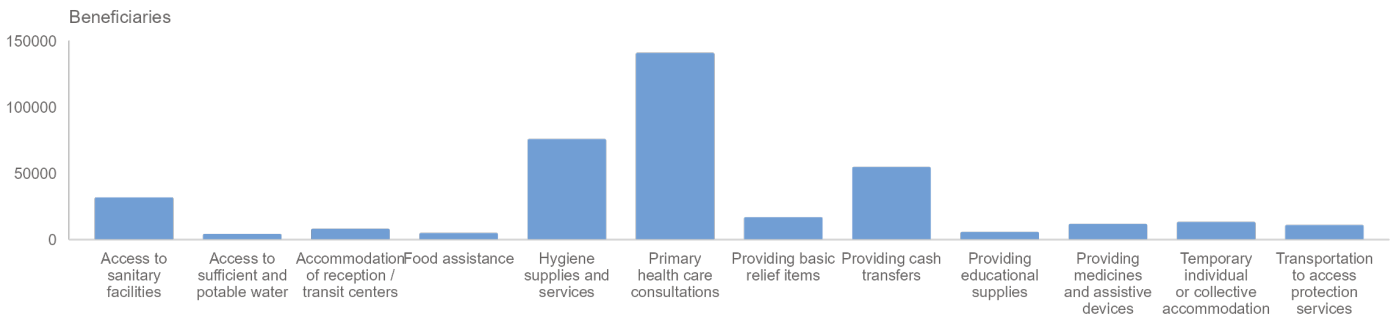

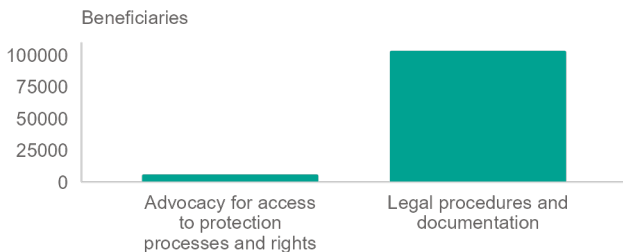

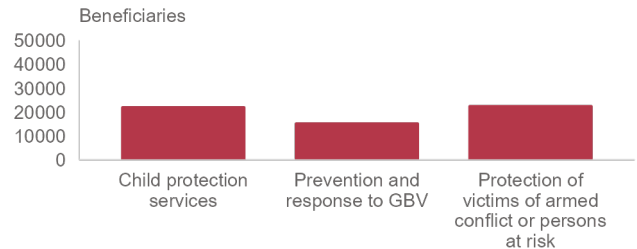
