## IGAD Region | Population of concern to UNHCR

As of 30 June 2024, the IGAD region is host to 5 million refugees and asylum-seekers. The majority of refugees and asylum-seekers are from South Sudan, currently at over 2.2 million. Some 20.8 million people are internally displaced in the region as a result of conflict and natural disasters. About 230,000 refugees have returned to their countries of origin since the beginning of 2024. The region also hosts over 87,000 stateless persons in Uganda, Kenya and South Sudan






